


Accessing the US Lacrosse Central Hub for Officials | 2014

This document will walk you through accessing the US Lacrosse Central Hub for official.


You will first need to start on the ArbiterSports main login page at www.arbitersports.com or the US Lacrosse Central Hub for Officials on ArbiterSports at www.uslacrosse.arbitersports.com

1. You will need to login into your account using your email address and password provided to you by ArbiterSports.




Please note – you must login using the email address account associated with your US Lacrosse Membership to access exclusive US Lacrosse member only content.

2. You should see the US Lacrosse Central Hub Account in your login screen if you are logged in with the correct email address. (If you are going through the uslacrosse.arbitersports.com page you will see “your name (official) in the top right)




If you do not see either of these it means the email account you entered is not the same as the email associated with your US Lacrosse membership. If this is the case please follow the next steps 3 - . If you do see the US Lacrosse CentralHub skip to step #

- To verify the email associated with your US Lacrosse membership please visit www.uslacrosse.org/myaccount. Login using your USL username and password. If you do not know this you can click on “what’s my username” and/or “forgot my password”.

- Once logged in verify the **PRIMARY** email associated with your account. If this is not the same email associated with your ArbiterSports account you use to receive games we recommend changing this to that email now.



Note: If you changed your email in the step above you will need to still login to ArbiterSports using your original email on file and change your email address there to match your updated email for US Lacrosse.


- Go back to www.arbitersports.com and login using the email associated originally with your US Lacrosse account. If this is your first time accessing this site using this particular email your password will be your last name all lowercase. If that does not work click “forgot password” on the top right.




- Once logged in if you want to change your email to merge your other accounts on Arbitersports or the new email you updated on US Lacrosse, click on the “my account” tab on the top right. If not proceed to “Step 8”



- If you choose to update your email address it is best to make sure it is the same on as on US Lacrosse. This will also allow your assigners to view your test scores, membership and certification activities with US Lacrosse if applicable. Edit your email address/username here and click “save.”



- Once you have your account usernames and emails set up the way you prefer you are all set to start exploring the US Lacrosse Central Hub and all that it has to offer!
